Round 2,763 to the nearest thousand.

<p>Step 1 First, find the place you wish to round.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2,763 ↑ thousands place</p>	<p>Step 2 Look at the digit to the right of the rounding place.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2,763 ↑ digit to the right</p>	<p>Step 3 If the digit is 5 or greater, increase by 1. If the digit is less than 5, do not change the digit.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2,763 ↑ 7 > 5 so increase by 1</p>

Since $7 > 5$, 2,763 rounds to 3,000.
